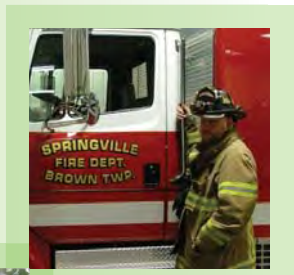

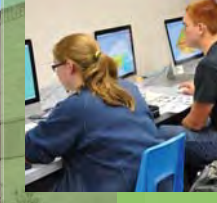
Extra-curricular Activities

Developing talents and skills early in a child's life has been an essential part of the success of Springville school's programs. In the fifth grade children are able to start learning to play instru-



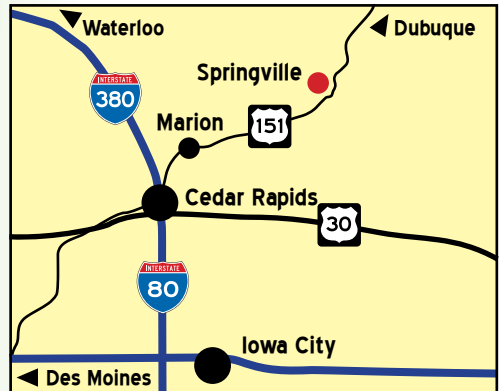
